


BOOK CLUB DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Have each person in your book club answer the following questions, going around the circle with one question at a time. If you can think of any other questions to include, feel free to add your own!



Who was your favourite character in the story? Why? 1. Which character did you least like? Why? 2. What event in the story surprised you the most? 3. What did you find to be the most memorable thing in the story? (could 4. be a character, a scene, a theme, or an aspect of the story world) Did anything in this story make you feel a strong emotion? (anger, 5. happiness, fear, sadness, disgust, excitement, etc.) Give an example or two of different emotions you felt while reading this story and what caused them. What did you think of the story's ending? Would you change anything 6. about it? If you could be a type of sprite, which race would you like to be? 7. (Feather, Bat, Bee, Dragonfly, Butterfly, or a mix of several?) Being a wingless sprite makes Asher's daily life more challenging 8. sometimes. What do you think would be the most frustrating part about not having wings in a world where everyone else does? Asher is forced to make a number of difficult decisions throughout the 9. story. What's one decision he makes that you agree with and why? What's one decision you disagree with and why? Virtues are good things, but sometimes people misunderstand them and 10. twist them into something bad. For example, Siobhan feels a strong sense of loyalty to Ryn, and this makes it difficult for her to clearly see the right decision to make. But loyalty itself is a virtue when wielded correctly. Can you think of an example of another "virtue" in the story that a character twists into a vice?
